JOHN R. ANDERSON V MEDICAL PAVILION

The John R. Anderson V Medical Pavilion is named in honor of the youngest son of Eileen and Jack Anderson. The Andersons donated \$25 million to help build the newest addition to Scripps Clinic, a 175,000-square-foot, multispecialty medical building on the campus of Scripps Memorial Hospital La Jolla.

The Anderson Medical Pavilion will be a center of medical excellence where physicians and staff advance medical research and education, and provide the same personal care and integration of services that distinguishes Scripps Clinic and Scripps Health in the San Diego community — and beyond.

Encompassing six floors and a lower level, the medical pavilion is connected to the Prebys Cardiovascular Institute and the Schaezel Center through corridors on the lower level and via pedestrian bridges on the second and fourth floors. Creating a crossroads of high-quality patient care, this state-of-the-art facility provides an array of services including:
